Important Notes:

- The arrival time is 15 minutes before commencement of exam. Students will not be considered in exam after 15 minutes of commencement time.
- Mobile, Laptop, Programming Calculator, any electronic devices or any type of reading materials are strictly prohibited in exam.
- Students must bring their belongings (like pen, pencil, sharpener, eraser, calculator, ruler or anything) by themselves. It is strictly prohibited to use other's belongings during exam.
